Rules:

- 4-H and FFA Members are eligible to compete.
- All animals must be owned by and in the physical possession of the exhibitor on or before March 31, 2010.
- Breed Shows: Angus, Hereford, Charolais, Simmental, AOB. There must be **8** head present to make a breed class
- Animals should be on the grounds by 5:30 pm EDT on Friday, July 16. Weigh-in will begin at 5:30 pm EDT and end at 6:30 pm EDT. Judging will begin immediately following the Beef Market Show.
- Health Papers must be presented at time of check in for validation.
- No artificial color or muzzles are allowed on animals at any time.
- An exhibitor may show no more than two animals per class and a total of 5 animals in the breeding show.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal in showmanship class.
- Breeding Beef Cattle Classes:**
 - Jr. Heifer Calf—Calved January 1 to April 30, 2010
 - Sr. Heifer Class—Calved September 1 to December 31, 2009
 - Summer Yearling—Calved May 1 to August 31, 2009
 - Jr. Yearling—Calved January 1 to April 30, 2009
 - Sr. Yearling—Calved September 1 to December 31, 2008
 - Cow/calf— A breed champion will be chosen from each breed and will have Supreme Champion Cow/Calf and Reserve Champion Cow/Calf.
 - Old Geezer showmanship contest for 35 and up during showman-ship contest. No entry fee required.
