### General Rules:

1. All dogs over 4 months of age must have been vaccinated against rabies to show at the Bluegrass Fair Dog Show. Current proof of rabies vaccination shall be presented upon registration the day of the show.
2. Additionally, exhibitors shall provide upon registration proof of (1) vaccination against Distemper, Parvo virus, and Hepatitis (DHLPP) and (2) examination by a licensed veterinarian within 150 days of the Bluegrass Fair Dog Show, stating that the dog is free from all contagious diseases or exposure thereto. All dogs shall be free of fleas and ticks or they will be asked to leave the show grounds.
3. Registration closes at 4:30pm (no late entries will be accepted). Health forms must be presented on the day of the show.
4. Dog must be trained by the 4-H member showing the dog.
5. An exhibitor may show no more than two dogs at the Bluegrass Fair 4-H Dog Show.
6. Dogs in season may not show. Mixed breed dogs may show.
7. 4-H'ers may wear clothing identifying their county and/or club.
8. Judges decisions are FINAL. If necessary, a Show Grievance Committee will review rule violations, calculations of scores, and dog behavior.
9. Limit one entry per dog per class. Exhibitors may enter up to 2 obedience classes.
10. The show committee has the right to ask an exhibitor to leave if a dog or person attacks for appears dangerous to another person or dog.

\*\*\* Best of Show winner is based on the combined highest score in 4-H obedience and 4-H showmanship.
